



## 2022 Canada Games Assistant Coach Nominations

**Tour Dates: August 2-August 12, 2022**

**Competition Dates: August 6-12, 2022**

**Location: Niagara Region**

**Full Team Size: 32 Athletes (24 Olympic Stream/4 Paralympic Stream/4 Special Olympians)**

### Available Coaching Positions:

- Olympic Stream: 2 Coaches
- Paralympic Stream: 1 Coach
- Special Olympics: 1 Coach

### Nomination Committee for Assistant Coaches

- Swim Ontario Performance Programs Manager or designate.
- 2022 Canada Games Team Ontario: Swimming Head Coach.
- Selected Coach from Sport Management Committee(TBC)

### Olympic Stream: 2 Assistant Coaches

### Eligibility Criteria

- All nominees must be a member in good standing with Swim Ontario, Swimming Canada and CSCTA.
- All nominees must be a minimum of NCCP Senior Coach Trained
- Must have completed the [Declaration of Availability for Team Selection: Coach](#)
- Nominee must meet the criteria as described in the [2022 Canada Games Technical Package](#).
- The nominee must be certified/trained no later than 90 days before the opening of the Games (May 8, 2022).
- The nominee must be the named Coach of Record of a selected swimmer(s).

### Selection Criteria

- Swimmers selected to the 2022 Canada Games Team Swim will be ranked based on percentage using World Class On Track times.
- Coaches of Record of the ranked swimmers shall be nominated, in order (alternating Female and Male swimmer), until the **two(2)** Assistant Coach Olympic Stream positions are filled.
- If a position is declined, the nomination shall go to the next highest ranked eligible Coach.
- To break a tie, the swimmers next highest On Track time will be utilized.



### **Paralympic Stream: 1 Coach(By Application)**

- Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements set out in the [2022 Canada Games Technical Package](#)
- Applicants must have a minimum of 3 years coaching experience working with para-swimmers
- Experience with or general knowledge of classification
- Applications are due to the Provincial and Performance Manager Christy Yaremczuk by Friday November 5, 2022

### **Special Olympics: 1 Coach(By Selection of Special Olympics)**

- The nominee must be fully certified at NCCP Fundamentals Coach and have completed the Special Olympics Canada Competition Introduction course.
- Must complete the Activity Leader Respect in Sport module and their Safe Sport certification
- Individual nominee must meet the criteria as described in the [2022 Canada Games Technical Package](#).
- Appointee by Special Olympics Ontario will be confirmed by Swim Ontario.

### **Team Ontario Training Camps**

- Coaches who accept their nomination are expected to make themselves available for the following training camps as well as the duration of the Games.
  - **Canada Games Team Camp: Date to be determined**
  - **Canada Games Pre-Competition Staging: August 2-5, 2022**

### **Appeals**

- Appeals are restricted to the alleged failure of the nomination committee to reasonably apply the nomination criteria.
- Appeals of a decision of the nomination committee must be made within 7 days of the date of nomination.
- Appeals must be made in writing to the CEO of Swim Ontario.
- There is an appeal application fee of \$250.00 that is payable with the notice of appeal prior to any appeal being considered. This appeal application fee is non- refundable.

### **Amendments and Unforeseen Circumstances**

- In the event of unforeseen or unusual circumstances, as determined by the Swim Ontario Nomination Committee, the committee shall have the full discretion to resolve the matter as it sees fit, taking into account factors and circumstances that it deems relevant
