



2022 Canada Summer Games Team Ontario Swimmer Nomination: Olympic Stream

Tour Dates: August 2-August 13, 2022 Competition Dates: August 7-12, 2022 Location: Niagara, Ontario

Team Size: 32 Athletes (24 Olympic Stream (12 per gender), 4 Paralympic Stream, 4 Special Olympics)

Canada Games Team Nomination Committee

- 1. Swim Ontario Provincial and Performance Programs Manager or designate.
- 2. 2022 Canada Games Team Ontario Swimming Head Coach.
- 3. Sport Management Committee member or designate.

Athlete Eligibility

Females Y.O.B 2006 or younger/Males Y.O.B 2005 or younger

- Must be fully registered in the Competition Open or Competition Development categories with Swim Ontario as of January 1, 2022.
- Must have completed the <u>Declaration of Availability for Team Selection: Swimmer</u> prior to April 1, 2022
- Eligible athletes must meet the Canada Summer Games eligibility criteria for nomination as a swimmer outlined in the <u>Niagara 2022 Technical Package</u>

Performance Eligibility Process

- <u>2021 SNC On Track Times</u> will be utilized as; Females 15-year-old Track 3 times and Males 16-year-old Track 3 times.
 Where an age-appropriate Track 3 time does not exist the next age category will be used (ie: Males 18-Year-Old 100 Breast.)
- Eligible LCM performances will be ranked as a percentage using On Track times as described above.

Eligible Performance Window: March 1-April 30th, 2022

Swim Ontario Provincial Program Vaccination Policy:

• All selected team members are required to follow the <u>Swim Ontario Provincial</u> <u>Program</u> <u>Vaccination Policy</u>





Eligible Competitions for Selection

- Swim Ontario will only consider results in Olympic Events from all sanctioned long course (LC) competitions within the Eligible Performance Window.
- Only results that appear on the Swimming Canada RTR will be considered.
- It is individually clubs or swimmers' responsibility to ensure that results are uploaded to the Swimming Canada RTR
- Results uploaded after Wednesday May 4th, 2022, will not be considered.

Eligible Events for Selection

****Only long course (LCM) performances done in Individual Olympic Events, no relay events, will be considered****

1. 50/ 100 Free	5. 100 Backstroke	9. 100 Butterfly
2. 200 Free	6. 200 Backstroke	10. 200 Butterfly
3. 400 Free	7. 100 Breastroke	11. 200 IM
4. 800/1500 Free	8. 200 Breastroke	12. 400IM

Athlete Nomination Process

- **12 FEMALES:** All eligible swimmers shall be ranked based on their performances in eligible competitions as a percentage of the Females 15-Year-Old Track 3 time and selected in rank order until the 12 highest ranked Individual Females are nominated in 12 Olympic event categories (1 swimmer per event.)
- The 50 or 100 Free and 800 or 1500 event categories will be filled by the highest individual scoring performance.
- **12 MALES:** All eligible swimmers shall be ranked based on their performances in eligible competitions as a percentage of the Males 16-Year-Old Track 3 time and selected in rank order until the **12 highest ranked individual Males are nominated in 12 Olympic event categories (1 swimmer per event.)**
- The 50 or 100 Free and 800 or 1500 event categories will be filled by the highest individual scoring performance.
- **ALTERNATES:** The next highest ranked swimmer in each individual event not already selected to the team will be designated as alternates for that event.
- **TIE BREAK:** Where there is a tie between two swimmers, the next highest On Track ranked performance, as described above in another event, for each swimmer, will be used.
- This process will be used until the tie is broken.





Team Selection Timelines

- Athlete nominations process immediately following the close of the performance window.
- Athletes must confirm acceptance of their nomination with Swim Ontario on or before 10:00 am on Friday May 6th, 2022, to <u>Stu McLean</u>

Amendments and Unforeseen Circumstances

• In the event of unforeseen or unusual circumstances, as determined by the Swim Ontario Nomination Committee, the committee shall have the full discretion to resolve the matter as it sees fit, considering factors and circumstances that it deems relevant.

Appeals Process

- Appeals are restricted to the alleged failure of the nomination committee to reasonably apply the nomination criteria.
- Appeals of a decision of the nomination committee must be made within 7 days of the date of nomination.
- Appeals must be made in writing to the CEO of Swim Ontario.
- There is an appeal application fee of \$250.00 that is payable with the notice of appeal prior to any appeal being considered. This appeal application fee is non-refundable.

Canada Games Event Entries

- All individual and relay entries shall be determined at the discretion of the Canada Games Head Coach and the Canada Games Coaching Staff.
- Swimmers may swim up to seven (7) individual events at the Canada Games, including the 5 K Open Water Race.
- Athletes selected for the 800/1500m events will be entered to swim the 5K Open Water event.
- Nomination does not guarantee specific event entry.
- Relays will be selected from within the team complement, at the discretion of the Canada Games Head Coach and the Canada Games Coaching Staff.

Team Ontario Team Initiatives

- Nominated swimmers are expected to make themselves available for the following team initiatives.
 - Canada Games Team Camp: July 11-12, 2022
 - Canada Games Pre-Competition Staging: August 2-5, 2022
