Section 2.02	<p>under new membership</p> <p>c) change “as” to by - (grammar edit)</p> <p>add the following to the section:</p> <p>d) The new Member has completed a probational period pursuant to Swim Ontario’s policies and procedures, during which the probational Member, provided it is in Good Standing, is entitled to participate in Swim Ontario competitions and events, save and except that probational Members are not entitled to vote or participate in Swim Ontario Members meetings during the probational period.</p>
Section 2.04	<p>d) Discipline – In addition to expulsion for failure to pay membership fees, each Member</p> <p>agrees to be subject to Swim Ontario’s policies and procedures concerning discipline,</p> <p>complaints, and appeals and may be subject to discipline up to and including expulsion from Swim Ontario pursuant to those policies and procedures.</p>
Section 3.21 Information Requests	Upon request, any Member shall be provided with a copy of the approved financial statements, auditor’s report or review engagement report and other financial information required by the By-laws or articles within 5 business days of the annual meeting.
Section 3.22 Adjournments	Notice of adjourned meetings will not be required unless the meeting is adjourned for more than 30 days.

Section 3.23 Persons Entitled to be Present	Members, Directors, and the auditors of the Corporation (or person appointed to conduct a review engagement) are entitled to attend meetings. Additional persons may be admitted only if invited by the Chair or with majority consent of the Members present at the meeting.
Section 4.05	<p>a) Each Director shall serve for a period of three (3) years. Each Director's term shall commence at the conclusion of the each A.G.M. at which such Director is elected.</p> <p>b) Subject to subsection c) below, a Director may serve for a maximum of three 3-year terms and is not eligible to stand for election for a fourth 3-year term.</p> <p>c) A Director who was elected or appointed to a term of less than 3 years is eligible to serve for one additional 3-year term.</p>
