

– Technical Meeting –



- The 800 and 1500 meter freestyle events will be swum, fastest to slowest, alternating women & men heats <u>during prelims</u> with the fastest heat swimming in finals on the day the event is scheduled.
- The Thursday mixed relays will be swum in finals only slowest to fastest.
- The Fri / Sat / Sun relays will swim slowest to fastest in <u>prelims</u> with fastest heat in finals.
- Prelims will be run in 10 lane heats
 - with the fastest three heats circle seeded for events 200M and less
 - and fastest two heats circle seeded for 400M events

Warm-ups

- Sprint and Pace lanes will be opened at
- Thursday: 12:55 and 17:25 for 25 mins
- Fri / Sat / Sun 8:15 and 16:55 for 35 and 25 mins respectively.
 - PARA only lane
 O until the sprint period begins
 - Pace lanes: 1 & 9
 - Sprint lanes: 0 & 8
 - Circle swimming lanes: 2 to 7
 - Backstroke Ledge: 0 & 8 available during sprint lanes times
 - Lane 0 in the south tank will be designated as PARA only lane throughout.
 - Backstroke Ledge will also be available *lane 9 in south tank* Flutter boards, pull-buoys, ankle bands & snorkels are allowed / no fins or paddles.

We request notification of Official Splits **30 mins before the start of the session.**

- Relays: 1st swimmer's time is an Official Split (no need to request)
- Requests Forms available at the Admin Desk



- Technical Meeting -

Swimmer Taping

- All swimmers shall be required to comply with World Aquatics taping rules.
- A committee shall be created to review taping requests. Swimmers who intend to use taping during the 2023 OJI meet must submit a request to Meet Management 45 mins before the start of the session.
- Taping Request Forms are available at the Admin Desk.
- Reviews will take place during warm ups for every session a swimmer is competing in order for the appropriate committee members to be available.
- All decisions of the committee are final.



- Technical Meeting -

Swim-Offs

- Coaches are to report to the Admin Desk when a swim-off is announced.
- All swim-offs are to be run during or at the end of the session in which the tie occurred at a time mutually agreed upon by coaches and officials.

- 6:00 PM for Saturday & Sunday

Scratches must be done on the <u>Scratch Online Form</u> or scratch cards at clerk of course Emailed scratches <u>WILL NOT</u> once this meeting starts.

2023 Ontario Junior International (OJI) – Technical Meeting – Relay Names Submission Deadline

- Coaches should submit their Relay names via Relay Forms provided by the Admin Desk
 - <u>30 mins BEFORE the start of the Session the event is being swum</u> in.



2023 Ontario Junior International (OJI) – Technical Meeting – Scratch Rules for Distance events

DISTANCE (800/1500 Free)

- Thursday distance events: 30 minutes following this meeting
- Sunday distance events: 30 minutes after the start of Finals the previous evening (Saturday Finals 6 PM).
- Scratches must be done on the <u>Scratch Online Form</u> or scratch cards at clerk of course
- Emailed scratches <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted following the Technical Meeting.

No update of entry times will be allowed



2023 Ontario Junior International (OJI) – Technical Meeting – Distance – Positive Check-in

- Positive Check-in will be in place for the 800m and 1500m Freestyle during the <u>preliminary warm-up period</u> to allow combination of heats or notification of swimmers moving to finals.
 - Scratches will not be accepted after the scratch deadlines of the previous evening.
- The Positive Check-in is a courtesy to fellow swimmers.
- Requests for swimmers scheduled in final to be moved to preliminaries will NOT be granted.

FINALS

 30 minutes following the completion of the Preliminary events (excluding time final events)

Thursday: <u>30 mins following completion of the 200 IM (Event 2)</u>

Friday: <u>30 minutes following completion of the 50 Back (Event 16)</u>

Saturday: 30 minutes following completion of the 50 Butterfly (Event 30)

Sunday: <u>30 minutes following completion of the 50 Breast (Event 44)</u>

 Emailed scratches <u>WILL NOT</u> be accepted. Scratches must be done on the <u>official</u> <u>scratch form</u> or scratch card at clerk of course



- Technical Meeting -

Scratch Rules (Penalties)

- "No-Shows", "step-downs" and "unexcused incomplete swims" will be penalized \$50.00 CAD for Preliminaries and Finals.
- Fines incurred in Preliminaries may be paid immediately, or at the end of the Preliminary session. The swimmer in question may swim other events in that Preliminary session prior to paying the penalty. Should the swimmer in question qualify for Finals, they shall not swim in Finals until the fine is paid.
- Fines incurred in Finals must be paid immediately. The swimmer in question may not swim other events until the fine is paid including relays.



- Technical Meeting -

Scratch Rules (Penalties)

- Fines will apply to all swimmers listed on the finals program no matter which position the swimmer placed in the preliminaries.
- Accepted payment is e-transfer to <u>etransfers@swimontario.com</u> or direct credit card payment via <u>OJI penalty online form</u>.
- No cash or cheques will be accepted at the Admin Desk.



2023 Ontario Junior International (OJI) – Technical Meeting – Ready Room / Call Room Check-in

- There will be NO positive check-in during the finals warm-up periods
- All individual finalists, including alternates <u>must</u> report to the Admin desk for Finals and check in with the Call Room Supervisor no later than 15 minutes in advance of their event.
 - Finalists will be replaced by alternates if they do not report to the ready room
 - A and B finalists will be marshalled in the Ready Room
 - Alternates are to remain in designated area until released by the Call Room Supervisor

For Finals, Relay teams are to check in at Admin Desk 15 min before scheduled race and remain in the designated area until released by the Call Room Supervisor.

Disqualifications and Protests

Disqualifications:

• Disqualifications will be announced and include event number, heat number and lane number.

Procedure for protests:

- Discuss DQ with the session Referee
- If not resolved, a written protest may be presented to the Referee. A written protest
 must be presented within 30 minutes after the conclusion of the <u>event</u> in question.
- If not resolved after discussion of the written protest, the matter may be assigned to a Jury of Appeal.

- There will be an "A" & "B" final for all Olympic Program Events
- A separate para swimmer final (10 swimmers) will be held for the following events
- 150/200 IM combined, fastest 10 swimmers based on para points
- o 50 Free, Back, Breast, Fly
- 100 Free & 100 Breast

Para swimmers will be ranked based on the following Paralympic point system: KNZB Points Table NED + Para 2020 in Splash software to allow points to be calculated with no restrictions on classification (non Paralympic events)

- CCES procedures (Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport) will be put into effect
