



Call for Applications: Head Coach

2025 CANADA SUMMER GAMES

Swim Ontario is seeking an enthusiastic and experienced person to be the Head Coach for the 2025 Canada Summer Games. The 2025 Canada Summer Games will be held in St. John's, Newfoundland.

Date:

Competition: August 10-15, 2025 Tour: August 8-17, 2025

Location: St. John's, Newfoundland

Team Size: 38 Members including 24 Olympic Stream Swimmers, 4 Paralympic Stream Swimmers, 4 Special Olympic Stream Swimmers, 4 Coaches and 1 Team Manager.

Term: April 1, 2024-August 31, 2025

The Head Coach, in conjunction with Swim Ontario Staff and the Team Manager will work over the next 18 months to ensure that all aspects of Team Ontario's preparation are in place for successful Games.

The Head Coach must be available and is expected to commit to the entirety of the tour as well as all activities related to the Canada Games prior to the specified Games dates.

If selected, you will be required to provide a letter from your employer/organization confirming that you will be available to attend the Games during these dates.

Key Responsibilities:

Pre-Games:

- Establish positive working relationships with the Swim Ontario Staff and selected Team Manager(s.)
- Become familiar with overall details of the 2025 Canada Games.
- Read and develop a clear understanding of all Team Ontario policies, procedures and documents
- as provided by Team Ontario.
- Clear understanding of the swimming technical package. (Pool and Open water).
- On-going communication, distribution of Team Ontario information, deadlines and Games
- details to Coaches and Swimmers
- Work with Swim Ontario staff to ensure information required by Team Ontario is compiled and
- collected by prescribed deadlines.
- Attend or participate in all meetings and functions related to the 2025 Canada Summer Games deemed necessary by the Chief Technical Officer of Swim Ontario, including but not limited to, the following;
 - o Technical Meetings
 - o Identification Camps
 - o Tentative Racing Tour





During the Tour:

- On-site leadership throughout the 8 days of the tour.
- Oversight and support of all Coaches and Swimmers support staff as required.
- Schedule and lead daily Staff meetings and provide necessary updates.
- Lead Coach/Swimmer meetings as required.
- Ensure all Team Ontario policies and procedures are followed.
- Complete other duties as assigned.

Post Games:

- Complete the final report
- Participate in post Games evaluations (as applicable).

Ideal Candidate:

- Will be a TEAM player!
- Will be in good standing with both Swim Ontario, Swimming Canada and Canadian Swim Coaches Association
- Will be enthusiastic, positive, fun and be ready to work hard with little supervision.
- Committed to leading the team for the entirety of the Tour.
- Strong interpersonal and written/verbal communications skills.
- Will have knowledge of competitive swimming at a provincial/national level.
- Knowledge and experience with Para-swimmers and Special Olympians is considered an asset.
- Previous provincial program exposure is an asset but is not a requirement of the position.

Qualifications:

- Must be <u>certified</u> NCCP Level 3/Senior Coach
- Must have on file, or submit either a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Check or an ENHANCED Police records Check (EPIC)
- Must have completed the Activity Leader Respect in Sport, NCCP Coaching Athletes with a Disability and Swimming Canada's Introduction to Para Swimming modules prior to application.
- Currently employed as a Coach with a Swim Ontario registered club for the 2023-2024 season
- Ability to communicate in French is considered an asset.
