1.1 **CALL TO ORDER**

Robinson will be acting as our voting administrator and all voting will take place on the online voting platform Simply Voting, which is a credible and authenticated third-party voting platform. J. Robinson has ensured that all registered voters are entered on the system, and that weighted voting is properly accounted for and tabulated within the system. J. Robinson is also a Certified Parliamentarian and will assist the Chair and the members in following our identified parliamentary procedure, which is Robert's Rules of Order.
