BOARD REPORTS

06-2021:04.1 **President**

Anne Bell provided a written report prior to the meeting. She reported that a note of thank you on the anniversary of COVID would be sent on behalf of the Board to staff and committees as part of the leadership team. In addition a tele-town hall will be offered for club Presidents during National Volunteer Week. The format and content still being developed.

06-2021:04.2 Finance and Audit Committee

- J. Peetsma provided a written report prior to the meeting and highlighted the following:
 - Registration excluding Officials at 59%, budget was based on 50% of previous year
 - Revenue short fall continues to occur with Competitions
 - COVID relief very favourable with further government support expected

- Expenses have been reviewed and adjusted to reflect the shortfall in revenue
- Projecting 200k surplus vs 236k loss.
- Even though we are showing favourable, we are still at 50% of previous year
- Budget Finance committee will review a 55% scenario so there will be a v.15

The Board discussed budget scenarios and tasked the Finance Committee to review and present a recommendation to the Board for the next meeting.

Shemilt added that a process of identifying pros and cons would be taken with goal to satisfy as many people as possible.
